Overview

Reality Ministries exists to create opportunities for adults with and without developmental disabilities to experience belonging, kinship, and the life-changing Reality of Christ's love. Our COmmunity Life Assistants (CLAs) are integral to this work through their presence and contributions to Reality's many program opportunities. Throughout the year, CLAs will grow in non-profit leadership, relational ministry, and, most importantly, friendship within Reality's beloved community.

Responsibilities

I. Program Support and Leadership

Much of the CLA's time each week is dedicated to planning, preparing, facilitating, and cleaning up after a wide range of weekly gatherings in CHapel Hill. In all of this, CLAs are helping to create a community of belonging for people of all abilities. The programs they support and lead are as follows:

- Interest Groups are times when people with (participants) and without (volunteers) developmental disabilities from the Reality community come together to engage in various activities of their choosing. These groups include things like yoga, song writing, Reality Gospel Choir, sports, bowling, gardening, discussion groups, and much more. Reality offers a wide array of activities, with the main goal of creating space for belonging and friendship. There are three 12-16 week seasons over the course of the year, with groups changing each season. New interns will support and/or lead several Interest Groups and Mingles throughout the year.
- Evening Gatherings are large, weekly programs that include lots of food, friendship, and celebration. Interns assist Community Leaders with any logistical matters related to running the Gatherings.

II. Community Care

Interns are expected to grow friendships with the participants and volunteers in the Reality community. This could include home visits, going to events such as Special Olympics' games, celebrating birthdays, or facilitating other special individual or small group outings.

III. Special Events and Camps

Interns work on all of Reality's special events and summer camps, including (but not limited to): Movie Night, Fall Fundraiser, Live Nativity, Kings and Queens Ball, Reality Talent Show, Overnight trips to the

mountains & Day Retreats to the Lake (early summer), as well as bi-monthly Community Worship gatherings.

IV. Miscellaneous

Interns may also cover a number of other assignments, such as representing Reality Ministries at community events, supporting our social media presence, PR Marketing work, writing thank you notes to donors, phone calls and mailings, welcome desk and other administrative tasks as needed.

Desired Qualifications

- Understanding of and commitment to the mission of Reality Ministries: *creating opportunities* for adults with and without developmental disabilities to experience belonging, kindship and the life-changing Reality of Christ's love
- Excitement about creating friendships with friends of all abilities
- Openness to new people and experiences
- Creativity, energy and desire to learn and grow
- Willingness to lead small groups in various activities
- Commitment to engaging with Reality staff's dedication to working towards becoming a community of racial equity and disability justice.
